Membership Policy

1. Purpose

This policy defines the membership categories, admission criteria, dues and conditions for maintaining membership.

2. Categories and Admission Criteria

Category	Criteria	Dues
Regular member	University degree in criminology or a related field and relevant duties.	\$125
Student member	Enrolment in a recognized criminology or criminal-justice program.	Free
Associate member	Professional in a related discipline supporting the Association's objects.	\$90
Honorary member	Person appointed by the Board for an exceptional contribution.	No charge

3. Admission Process

1. Submission of the membership form and supporting documents.
2. Review of the file by the admissions committee.
3. Written undertaking to abide by the Code of Ethics.
4. Payment of dues and confirmation of membership.

4. Rights and Obligations

- All members receive services in the official language of their choice.
- Only regular members in good standing vote and stand for election.
- Every member complies with the bylaws, policies and code of ethics.

5. Renewal

Membership renews annually. Notice is sent 30 days before expiry. Non-payment within 60 days results in suspension.

6. Resignation and Readmission

A member may resign by written notice. Readmission is possible upon payment of dues owed and review of the file.
