Privacy Policy

The NBPAC is committed to protecting the personal information it collects, in accordance with applicable legislation.

1. Information Collected

- Contact details (name, address, email, telephone).
- Eligibility information (education, experience).
- Dues and continuing-education records.
- Preferred official language.

2. Purposes

Information is used to manage membership, communicate with members, administer continuing education and ethics, and meet legal obligations.

3. Consent

By joining, the member consents to the collection and use of their information for the purposes described. Consent may be withdrawn, subject to legal and contractual obligations.

4. Disclosure to Third Parties

The Association does not sell or rent personal information. It is disclosed only with consent or where required by law.

5. Security and Retention

Reasonable administrative, physical and technical measures protect the information, kept only as long as necessary then securely destroyed.

6. Access and Correction

Any member may review their information and request corrections by writing to confidentialite@apcnb.ca.

7. Bilingual Service

Any privacy request is handled in the official language chosen by the individual.
